The Gospel of John, chapter 8, reveals the motive of the Pharisees to constantly question and deny that Jesus was the Son of God, Son of Man, Son of David. Their question, "The Father sent You?" Jesus answered, "He who sent Me is with Me—the Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him." To the Jews who believed Him, He said, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed." . . . "You shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free."

Today, as in the days that Messiah Yeshua walked the streets of Jerusalem, there is a path to the Mount of Olives and then to Golgotha. This path also holds the footsteps of the Messianic Believers. They have a zeal for God, but not in accordance with knowledge. For not knowing about God's righteousness and seeking to establish their own, they [do] not subject themselves to the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

What Israel is seeking, it has not obtained, but they were hardened; just as it is written:

"GOD GAVE THEM A SPIRIT OF STUPOR, EYES TO SEE NOT AND EARS TO HEAR NOT, DOWN TO THIS VERY DAY."

(Isaiah 29:10; Jeremiah 5:21)

Yet, God has not rejected His people whom He foreknew. From the standpoint of God's choice they are beloved for the sake of the fathers.

"THE DELIVERER WILL COME FROM ZION, HE WILL REMOVE UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB." "THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM, WHEN I TAKE AWAY THEIR SINS."

(Isaiah 59:20-21, 27:9)

So then it does not depend on the man who wills or the man who runs, but on God who has mercy.

For just as you once were disobedient to God, but now have been shown mercy because of their disobedience, so these also now have been disobedient, that because of the mercy shown to you they also may now be shown mercy.

For God has shut up all in disobedience so that He may show mercy to all. Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways!
