Our Father, sparing no expense, goes to search for them, to bring them home. *meditate and pray: Psalm 130; Luke 15*

• Most chaplains have been reduced to a tolerance mantra, "All faiths are good."

ASKing Psalm 145:4

Military outposts are a haven of spiritual activity ... false gods are worshipped openly alongside the living God. *meditate and pray: Ezekiel 34*

• Military families often live on the fringe, yet, like the woman at the well, they are potential urban missionaries ... Jesus transforms them and then their entire community. *meditate and pray: John 4*

May all the military engage the Warrior with the sword coming out of His mouth.
