Worship

"Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name ... " (1 Chronicles 16:29)

- Praise God for His sovereignty over the situation in Afghanistan and His compassion for the Afghan people
- ASK for the body of Christ in Afghanistan (both Afghans and internationals) to be strengthened in worship. For the freedom, courage, and faith to proclaim truth in worship and to rejoice in the Lord in the midst of struggles and insecurity.

Peace

"They shall build houses and inhabit them; they shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit. They shall not build and another inhabit; they shall not plant and another eat...They shall not toil in vain or bear children for calamity; for they will be a people blessed by the LORD..." (Isaiah 65:21–23)

- ASK for stability throughout the country. For a lasting peace that encourages people to invest in their land and communities again. For rest and healing for Afghans weary and scarred by decades of violence.
- ASK for an end to the repetitive and retaliatory cycles of conflict in Afghanistan, both at a national level as well as among tribal and family groupings.

Leadership

"...each ruler will be like a hiding place from the wind, a shelter from the storm, like streams of water in a dry place, like the shade of a great rock in a weary land." (Isaiah 32:1–2)

- ASK the Lord to raise up and nurture Afghan leaders of integrity, who will model public service, work for justice, and earn the trust of their communities.
- ASK for them to have the courage to remain upright and honest in the face of rampant corruption and that God would bless and protect them and their families.
